ADMISSIONS CRITERIA FOR PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS

National Senior Certificate or NQF Level 4 National Certificate (Vocational) with an endorsement for entry in to Bachelor studies. Minimum rating of 4 (50-59%) in at least 4 matric subjects (excluding LO). Minimum total rating of 25 APS points (excluding LO). Minimum rating of 4 (50-59%) for English Home Language or a minimum of 5 (60-69%) for English First Additional Language. Minimum rating of 4 (50-59%) for Mathematical Literacy or a minimum of 3 (40-49%) for Mathematics.

HIGHER CERTIFICATE: FITNESS (YEAR 1, NQF 5, 137 CREDITS) - CHE

The Higher Certificate in Fitness will qualify you to work in the fitness industry as a personal trainer, fitness instructor / trainer or wellness consultant. The programme includes subjects like Anatomy, Physiology, Kinesiology (Exercise Science), Training Principles and Methods as well as Fitness Business Management. Once qualified, students can look for workplace opportunities in South Africa and abroad within health clubs and fitness centres or start their own fitness business / practice. Students who qualify are also automatically registered on REPSSA (Register of Exercise Professionals South Africa) which links to other REPS registers in the world and gives the students international workplace opportunities around the world in health clubs and on cruise ships.

DIPLOMA IN SPORT AND EXERCISE (YEAR 1 OR 2, NQF 6, 370 CPEDITS) - CHE

This course provides theoretical and practical education along with relevant sport and fitness related field training.

Qualifying students are able to:

- Apply the science of testing and evaluation to the BBe design, management and implementation of sport skills and techniquebased training programmes
- Design, implement and manage safe and effective sport conditioning and/or performance-based exercise programmes
- Use current information technology to analyse, interpret, and prescribe correct movement patterns, sporting tactics and movement execution
- Coach a chosen sport by applying professional coaching principles
- Design and periodise safe and effective sport performance programmes
- Synthesise theoretical and scientific theory of coaching and/or exercise science into a practically applied training or conditioning programme

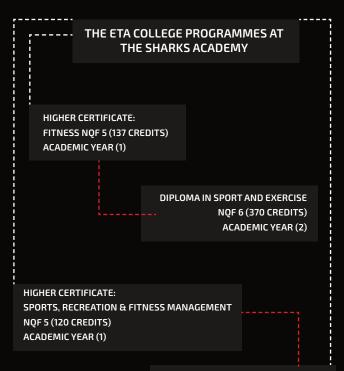

DEGREE ADMISSION CRITERIA

Admission Criteria for prospective students who matriculated as of 2008: National Senior Certificate (NSC) or equivalent with an achievement rating of at least 3 (40%-49%) in English Home or 4 (50%-59%) in English First Additional Language, plus an achievement rating of 3 (40%-49%) in Mathematics or 5 (60%-69%) in Mathematical Literacy. Bachelor's Degree

Recognition of Prior Learning:

pass is required.

A CV and RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) application is required from prospective students over 23 years of age, who have do not qualify for a degree, and must include work experience.



OVERVIEW

The Sharks Academy Gap Year Programme provides students with access to a one year life experience in which to discover and create their platform for life and at the same time pursuing a career in sport by participating in one of our sporting programmes.

The Programme will provide students with knowledge to complete identified tasks which will ultimately lead to achieving an end goal on completion of specific projects.

Gap Year Programmes often solve issues of academic burnout by providing healthy choices and satisfying the need for further exploration in different careers. They re-ignite a sense of curiosity for learning, through real life situations and exploring possible careers through hands-on field work. It takes the student out of 'park' and helps put them into 'drive'!

BENEFITS OF THE GAP YEAR PROGRAMME

Opportunities are provided for students to explore different career pathways while at the same time gain useful everyday skills for use in their daily lives. It also provides time for these school leavers to assess and experience different career, study and work options.

Students (and their parents!) at a high school level often make pressured decisions on their academic pathway which result in course changes or dropouts. Most students are able to discover their own niche and life path once they have had time to emotionally mature well away from the school environment.

This will be a year in which they will mature and grow while finding themselves – critical to long term life fulfillment, increased self-awareness and self-confidence.

The Programme is divided into three components, namely Life Skills, Practical Skills (eg. Plumbing, Woodworking, Culinary Development, Basic Ecotourism and Ecology, Outdoor Leadership), and an Outreach Programme (eg. Housing Projects, Foot Kitchen Projects)
